

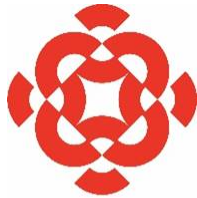

“In considering the ASCAP and BMI consent decrees, I would like the Department of Justice to know the ASCAP and BMI consent decrees are important to me because our non-profit works on a margin of less than 1% per year in service to our community-based mission. We cannot carry an additional burden on behalf of music licensing. Their demand is an over-reach into lines of business of which they are not reasonably associated. They have not negotiated in any manner with the non-profit community; there has been no good faith communication. There has been zero transparency and no case built for their demand. We vigorously object to any such increased fee basis.”
